  - Serves as the primary teaching hospital for the University of South Alabama College of Medicine
  - Major referral center for southern Alabama, southern Mississippi, and portions of northwest Florida
  - Services include: Level I Trauma, Burn Center, Cardiovascular Disease, Strokes, Organ Transplantation, and Sickle Cell Disease

### USAMC


- Teaching site for medical students, family practice residents, internal medicine residents, nursing students, and physician assistant students

## USA Children's and Women's



- The University of South Alabama Children's and Women's Hospital is one of six free-standing hospitals in the nation providing care to children, women and infants.
- Serve a large region, which extends in an arc from eastern Louisiana, through the state of Mississippi, to northern Alabama, to northwest Florida
- Provide services to meet the needs of women during all the stages of pregnancy, throughout labor and delivery and for gynecological needs
- Infant services include a Level III Neonatal Intensive care unit and a newborn nursery
- Pediatric services include a Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, an Infant Toddler Preschool Unit and a Schooled-age, Adolescent unit
- Emergency services also available for pediatric and obstetric patients
- Surgical services available for women, children and infants

## USA Children's and Women's

- HSP and Medicine rotations
- Pediatrics (Allison Chung, PharmD)
  - Rotation consists of direct patient care services based in the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit
  - Participation in interdisciplinary rounds along with the preceptor will occur on a daily basis
  - Participation in clinic activities such as the HIV clinic or
  - Breathmobile- mobile asthma education unit occur on a weekly basis

- Primary Care (Ray Lorenz, PharmD)
  - AltaPointe Health Systems
  - Regional community behavioral health organization
  - Manages and provides comprehensive mental health services through a network of providers to individuals, families and the community
  - Services include outpatient and residential care for children, adolescents, adults and senior adults.
  - Professional staff that includes psychiatry, clinical psychology, nursing, social work, counseling, education, case management, clinical pharmacist and support staff

- 704-bed acute care hospital
- Largest non-governmental, not-for-profit hospital in Alabama
- Rotations: HSP, Medicine, Elective-Hospital Pharmacy Management
- Services: Surgical, Cardiovascular, Oncology

- 467 beds state facility offering full-service psychiatric care
- Located in nearby Mount Vernon, AL
- Rotations: Primary Care, Elective
